

NAME OF THE PROJECT: PROJECT MANAGEMENT TRAINING FOR CONTRACTORS

TERMS OF REFERENCE

1.INTRODUCTION OF THE PROJECT

Mbizana local municipality has an estimated population of 281 905 within an area covering 2 806 km². Within the Alfred Nzo District Municipality, Mbizana has a largest population compared to other three municipalities under Alfred Nzo District Municipality, but it is the second largest in number of households.

Mbizana is faced with a high number of contractors who are mainly participating within the civil and building space. The majority of contractors do not have expertise in the sector, as such most contractors do not move beyond entry level. The municipality has a contractor development policy which was formed during the municipal contractor development programme in the year 2014. The programme was created in order to address challenges experienced in developing self sustainable contractors, lack of expertise and contractors not moving beyond entry level.

Given that the mega project of N2 wild coast development is already underway and the municipality also has two mega projects in the form of the Mputhumi Mafumbatha Stadium and the Civic centre, it becomes imperative that contractors are capacitated in skills that will enable them to be competitive and fully participate in all infrastructure development projects within the local space and beyond. The Municipality needs to support contractors with managerial and technical skills. Furthermore, it is the Municipality's intention to ensure economic sustainability and viability of the SMMEs by reinforcing the institutional and individual capacity of those who are involved in the aforementioned sector.

2.REQUEST

Mbizana local municipality therefore, seeks to procure services of a suitable and experienced service provider who will be able to provide accredited training on Project Management for 20 contractors of Mbizana Local Municipality.

3.OBJECTIVES

- To ensure capacity development of previously disadvantaged contractors
- Improve the performance of previously disadvantaged contractors in terms of managing project.
- Improve the business management and technical skills of these contractors.
- Insure that contractors meet bidding standards
- Improve the ability of local contractors to compete with bigger construction firms.

- Training of twenty contractors in Project Management.
- The project time bound will be 3 days


